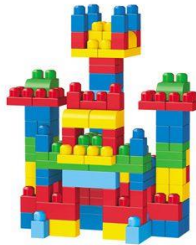


Art At Home

Create a colour wheel with house hold objects and take a picture.



Using Lego or blocks create a 3D sculpture, if you have enough blocks you could then create an art gallery for it to go in.



Find a mirror at home and draw a self-portrait. Add colour.



Complete an observational still-life drawing of something in your home. Example: tea-pot, vase, fruit, pot plant.



Go in your backyard and create a piece of art using natural material. Example, leaves, grass, sand, sticks, pebbles. If you have an iPad look at some of Andy Goldsworthy's Art for ideas.



Andy Warhol Soup Can Design your own can of soup. What is inside? What does the label look like?



Using an iPad, phone or camera go outside to try and capture a shot of something wild! It could be a bird, insects or even a pet!



Using a piece of paper design a paper aeroplane. See how far it can fly. You could watch Paper Planes for some inspiration.



Using toys at home create a stop motion film using the Stop Motion Studio App.
